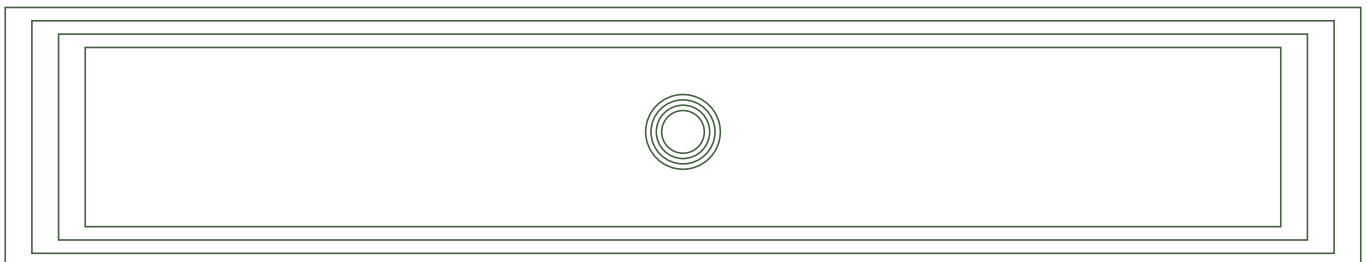

STOP ANY TIME

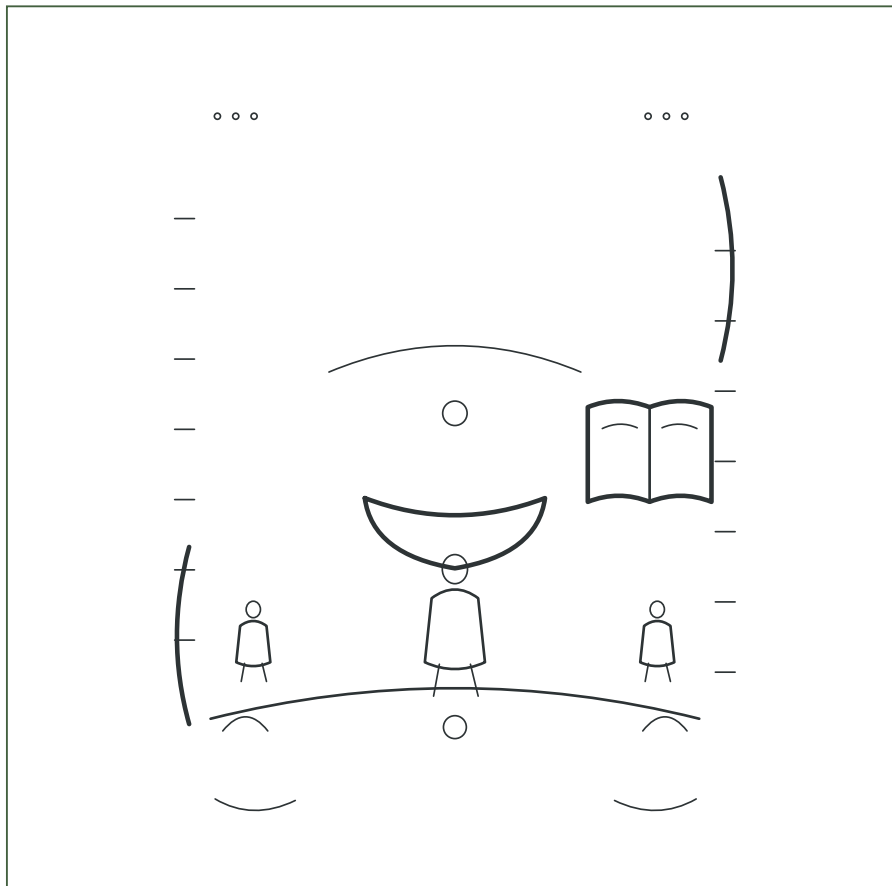
You do not have to keep going. We can stop, move, get water, or sit with a trusted adult.

PARAPHRASE

Truth can hold a person together so words
and actions are honest and dependable.

CONTEXT

The armor image becomes a cloth sash and
notebook, familiar objects for honest words.

REFLECTION

Use an invented example and let the
adult model clarity. A child can color,
listen, or pass.

PROMPT

Where could a truthful word make a
situation clearer? You may invent a
fictional example, color, or pass.

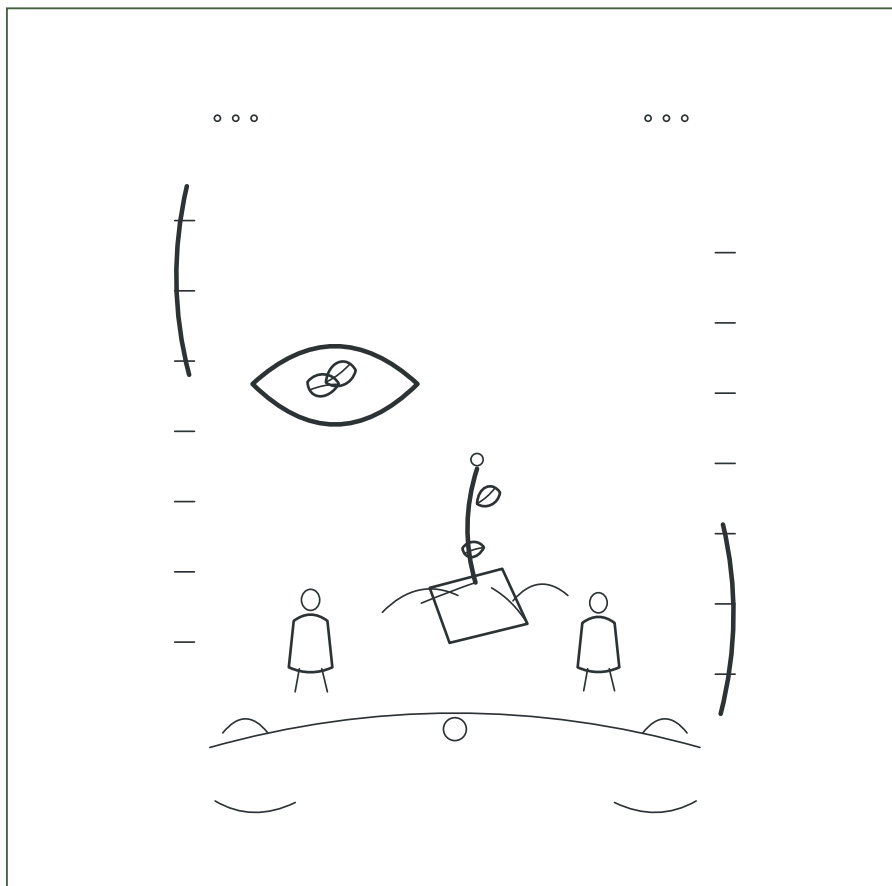
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Child in everyday clothes wears a fabric sash
beside an open notebook and supportive

PARAPHRASE

Right action can help protect a community
when it includes fairness, mercy, and repair.

CONTEXT

The protective image becomes a repair panel,
connecting right action with care.

REFLECTION

Notice the visible repair and let the
adult offer a choice. A child may point,
draw, listen, or pass.

PROMPT

What repair is visible in this fictional
scene? You may point, draw, listen, or
pass.

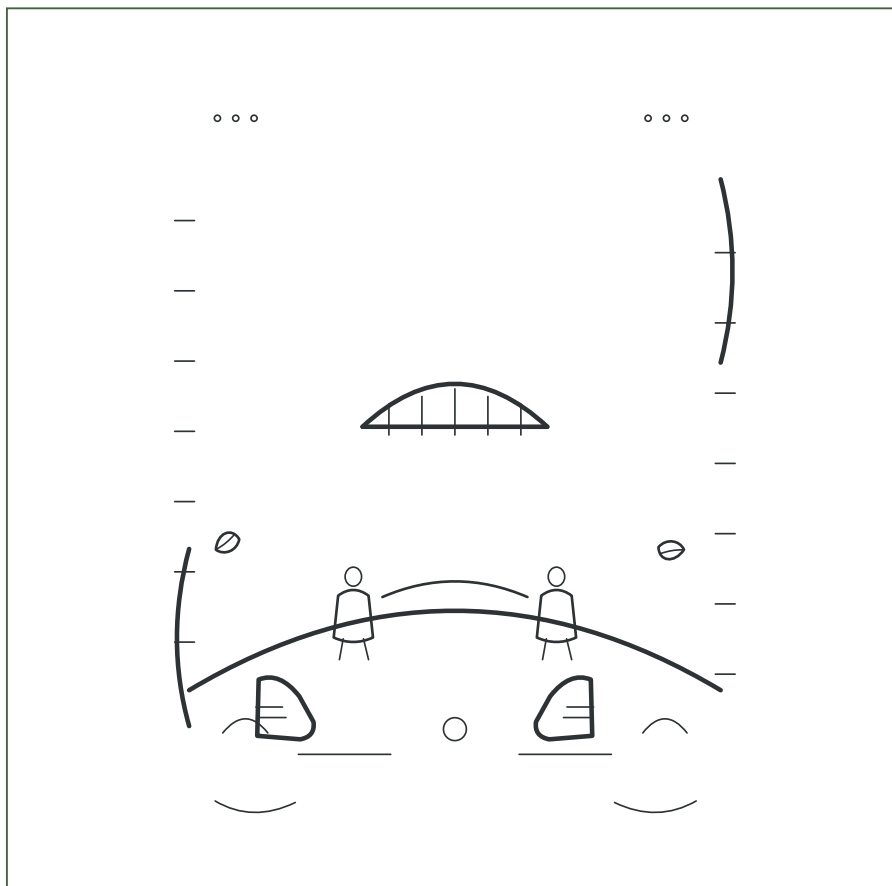
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

REFERENCE

Ephesians 6:15

PARAPHRASE

Peace makes a person ready to move toward reconciliation, safety, and good news.

CONTEXT

Soft shoes make readiness concrete: moving toward peace while listening for consent.

REFLECTION

Trace the open path or choose another response. A child may color, use AAC, or pass.

PROMPT

Where does this path make room?
Trace it, choose colors, use AAC, or pass.

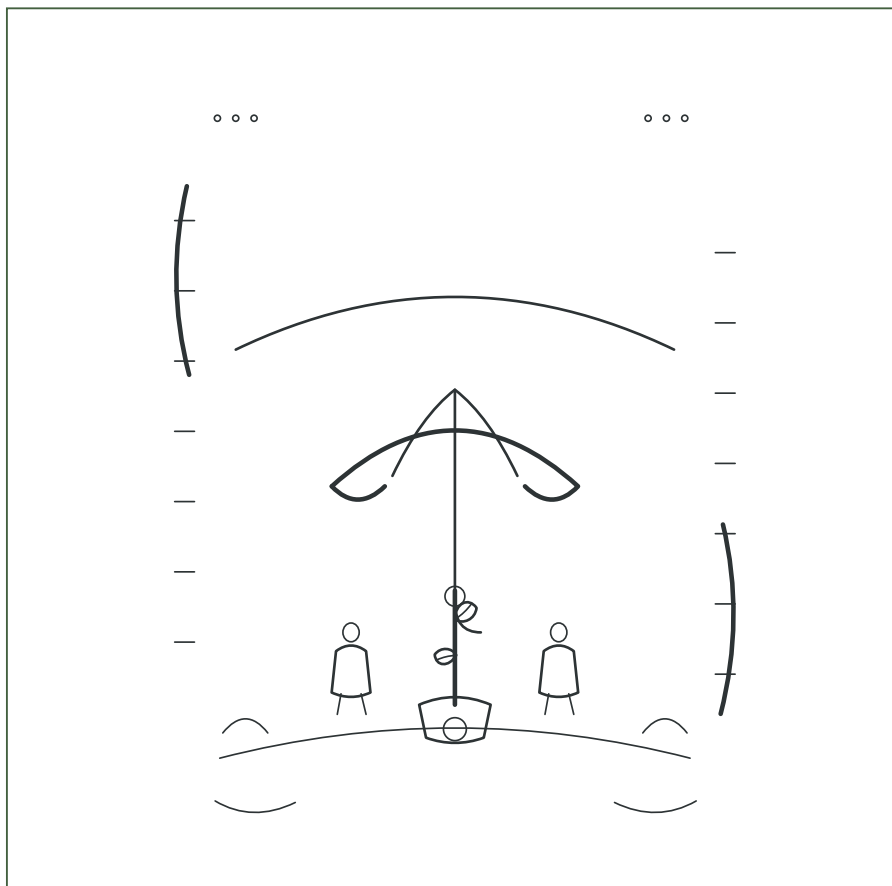
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Soft-soled shoes lead toward a bridge and two people making room on a path.

PARAPHRASE

Faith can help someone stand with trusted
people when fear or hurt arrives.

CONTEXT

The umbrella makes faith a picture of shared
shelter and trusted support.

REFLECTION

An adult can name real helpers;
coloring, listening, AAC, and passing all
fit.

PROMPT

Who or what can offer wise support in
this fictional picture? Adults name real
helpers; children may color or pass.

IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Umbrella-shaped shield rests beside a child
and trusted adult under a porch.

Helmet of salvation

Ephesians 6:17

PARAPHRASE

Salvation is God's rescue and belonging; the helmet image points to a mind held by hope.

CONTEXT

The open doorway makes salvation a picture of belonging and hope.

REFLECTION

Treat the doorway as a story image and invite listening, drawing, pointing, AAC, or passing.

PROMPT

What could the open doorway mean in this story? You may listen, draw, point, or pass.

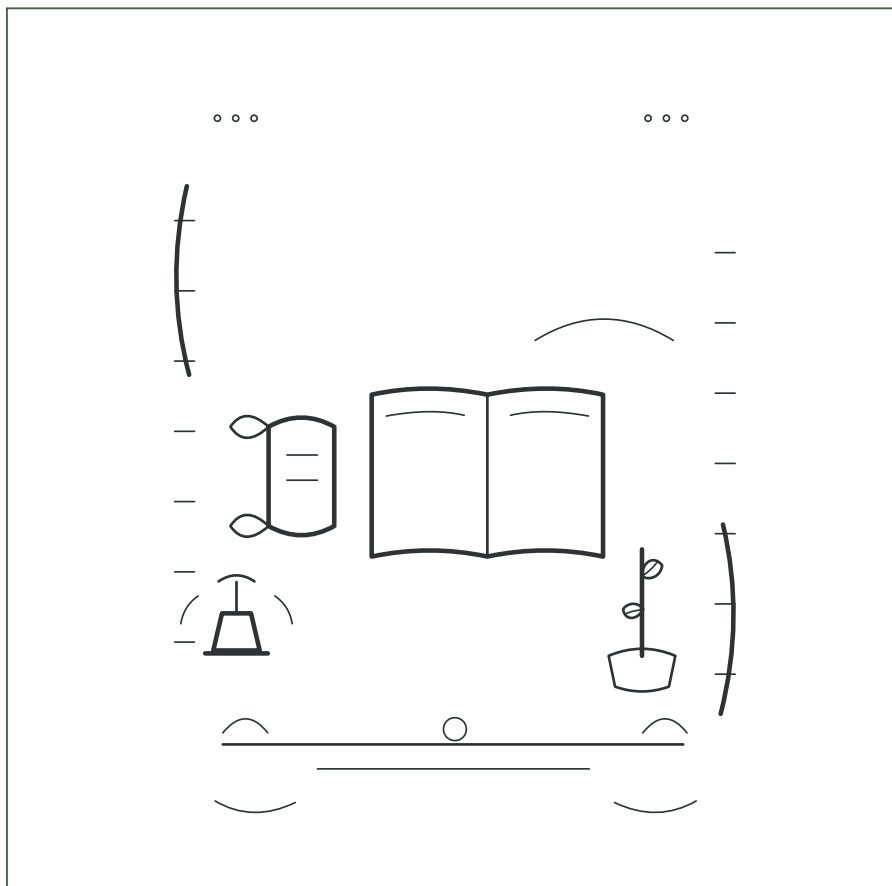
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Leaf-and-lamp helmet rests beside a path leading to an open doorway.

CONTEXT

The text image points to Scripture read with
context and wisdom.

REFLECTION

Let an adult model reading before
acting. A child can point to a shape,
listen, or pass.

PROMPT

What might a careful reader notice
before acting? You may point to a
shape, listen, or pass.

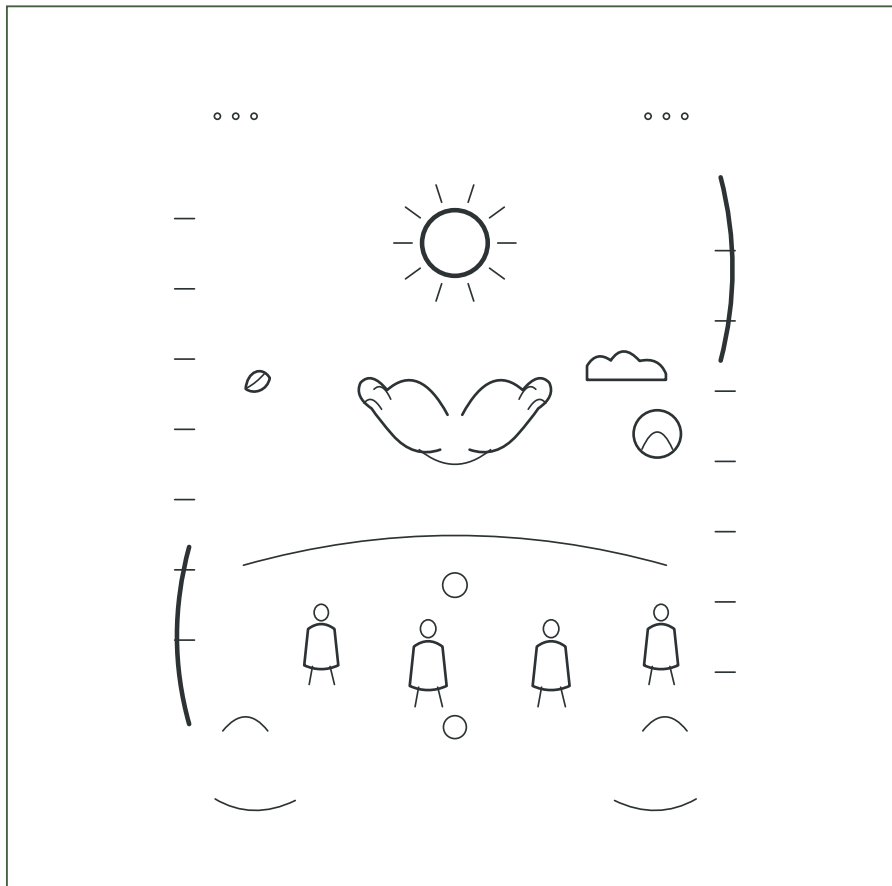
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Open scroll and child-safe book rest beside a
plant and reading lamp.

Prayer in every season

REFERENCE

Ephesians 6:18

PARAPHRASE

Prayer can be an ongoing conversation and care for others in every season.

CONTEXT

The closing instruction brings prayer into the whole metaphor and leaves posture and words open.

REFLECTION

Offer open eyes, movement, AAC, quiet, or a pass. Prayer remains optional and adult-mediated.

PROMPT

What kind of help or gratitude could an adult hold in prayer? You may listen, use AAC, keep eyes open, or pass.

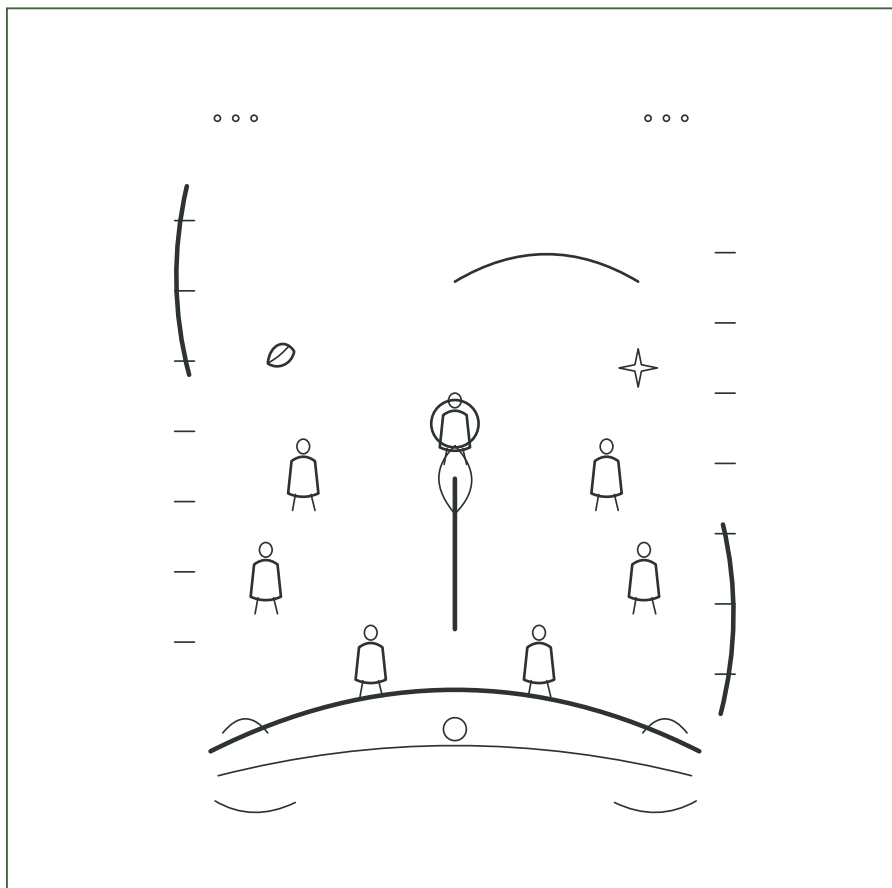
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

REFERENCE

Ephesians 6:10-18

PARAPHRASE

The whole picture invites a community to stand together in truth, peace, faith, Scripture, and prayer.

CONTEXT

The community circle gathers the symbols around shared prayer and an open path.

REFLECTION

Invite one fictional, observable practice; a child may choose, listen, or pass.

PROMPT

Which peaceful practice could a group try today? Choose one, invent a fictional idea, or pass.

IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Diverse community stands in a circle holding peaceful symbols with an open path.
