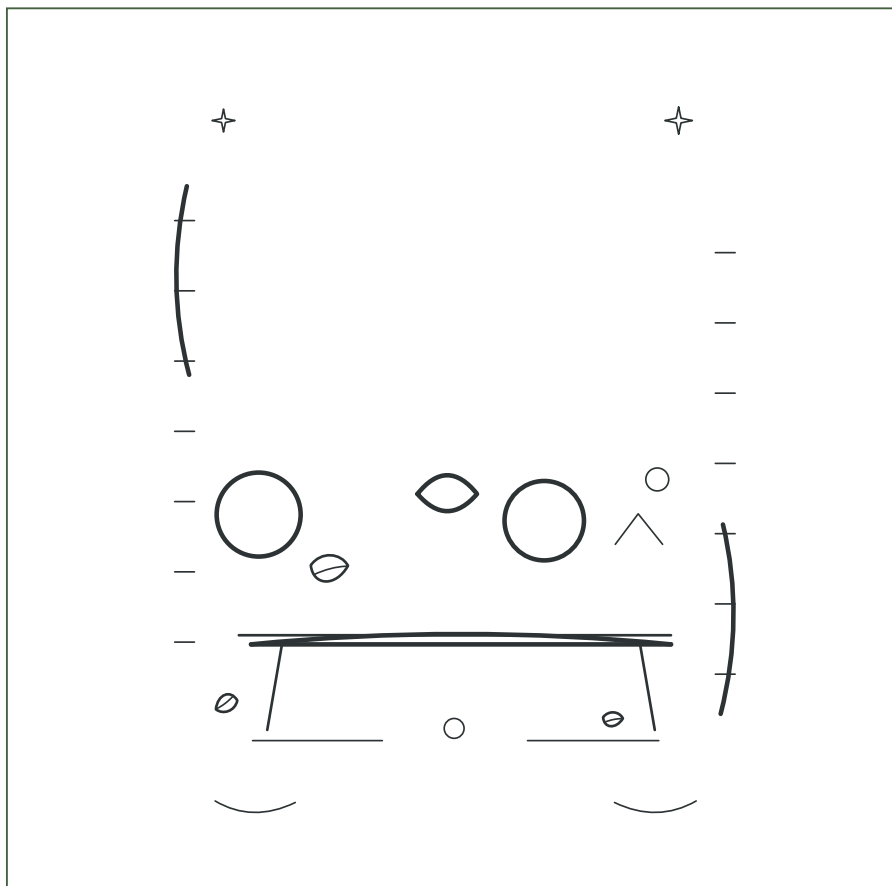

CONTEXT
