ADAPT · EVERY CARD

You may listen, choose another activity, or pass. Eyes may stay open, and movement or drawing is welcome.

Do not use a card as a compliance chart, reward, threat, or substitute for a boundary or qualified care.

Belonging and creation **Made with care**

REFERENCE Psalm 139:13-14

CUE I am made with care, and my life has value.**CONTEXT** The psalm praises God's knowledge and the wonder of embodied life; it does not rank bodies or abilities.**PROMPT** Draw a pattern or name one way an adult can treat a body with care.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Belonging and creation **Known and honest**

REFERENCE Psalm 139:1-6

CUE God sees me fully, so I can be honest before God.**CONTEXT** Being known is an invitation to truthful prayer, not surveillance or a demand to explain everything.**PROMPT** Use the words I am here, or listen without speaking.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Belonging and creation **Welcomed by Jesus**

REFERENCE Mark 10:13-16

CUE Jesus welcomes children; I belong in his care.**CONTEXT** Jesus receives children when adults try to send them away. Welcome includes dignity, access, and safeguarding.**PROMPT** Choose a fictional way to make room for someone.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Belonging and creation **Loved beyond performance**

REFERENCE Romans 8:38-39

CUE God's love is not measured by performance or being quiet.**CONTEXT** The passage speaks of God's love in Christ amid trouble; it does not say difficult circumstances cannot happen.**PROMPT** Replace a score-card drawing with a welcome symbol.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Grace, repair, and new life **Grace is a gift**

REFERENCE Ephesians 2:8-9

CUE Grace is a gift; I do not earn God's love by getting everything right.**CONTEXT** The passage turns attention away from boasting and toward gift. A child does not need a perfect record to belong.**PROMPT** Receive the card silently or thank God for grace.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Grace, repair, and new life **Begin again with help**

REFERENCE 2 Corinthians 5:17

CUE In Christ I can begin again, with truth and help.**CONTEXT** New creation is God's work, not a demand to pretend yesterday did not happen or to avoid repair.**PROMPT** Draw a repaired path; an adult may name one ordinary repair.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Grace, repair, and new life **Truthful repair**

REFERENCE 1 John 1:9

CUE When I fail, I can tell the truth and seek repair without shame.**CONTEXT** Confession is honest turning and received forgiveness; it never asks a child to disclose abuse or accept harm.**PROMPT** Practise a fictional sentence: I was wrong; how can I help repair it?LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Grace, repair, and new life **Correction without condemnation**

REFERENCE Romans 8:1

CUE In Christ, condemnation is not my identity; I can receive wise correction.**CONTEXT** Freedom from condemnation is not freedom from accountability, boundaries, or help with a repair.**PROMPT** Say help me learn, draw, or choose a listening route.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Presence, prayer, and help **Presence and practical help**

REFERENCE Matthew 28:20; Psalm 34:18

CUE God is with me in ordinary days and hard days, and adults can help me too.**CONTEXT** Presence does not make every danger disappear; practical help and a trusted adult remain important.**PROMPT** Point to a trusted-adult or help card.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Presence, prayer, and help **Help in weakness**

REFERENCE Romans 8:26

CUE The Holy Spirit helps people when they are weak or do not know what to pray.**CONTEXT** Weakness is not spiritual failure. Prayer can be a word, a sigh, a drawing, or an adult's words.**PROMPT** Use one word such as help, thank you, or I do not know.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Presence, prayer, and help **Ask for wisdom**

REFERENCE James 1:5

CUE I may ask God for wisdom and ask trusted people for help.**CONTEXT** Wisdom is received and practised in community; a child does not solve an adult problem alone.**PROMPT** Choose ask, listen, or pause.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Presence, prayer, and help **Lament belongs**

REFERENCE Psalm 13

CUE Honest lament belongs in faith; I do not have to pretend.**CONTEXT** The psalm holds complaint, asking, and trust together. A hard feeling does not cancel belonging.**PROMPT** Draw a cloud and a light, or leave the card face up without words.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Community and neighbour love **Part of a body**

REFERENCE 1 Corinthians 12:12-27

CUE I am part of a body; I need others and my gifts can serve others.

CONTEXT Difference and interdependence belong in the picture; no gift makes a person more valuable.

PROMPT Name a fictional team contribution or use AAC and pointing.

LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK · AAC · PASS

Community and neighbour love **Practise compassion**

REFERENCE Colossians 3:12-14

CUE I can practise compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience as I learn.

CONTEXT These are practices shaped by love, not a behaviour score or a demand to hide emotion.

PROMPT Choose one word to draw with a symbol.

LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK · AAC · PASS

Community and neighbour love **Love with boundaries**

REFERENCE Mark 12:31; Proverbs 4:23

CUE I can love my neighbour while keeping wise boundaries.

CONTEXT Love never requires staying near someone unsafe or keeping a dangerous secret.

PROMPT Sort fictional examples into ask an adult and kind action.

LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK · AAC · PASS

Community and neighbour love **Peacemaking with truth**

REFERENCE Matthew 5:9; Romans 12:18

CUE I can make peace without calling harm good.

CONTEXT Peacemaking includes truth, justice, boundaries, and help; it is not forced reconciliation.

PROMPT Practise a general sentence: We need a trusted adult to help.

LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK · AAC · PASS

Rest, hope, and truthful voice **Receive rest and help**

REFERENCE Matthew 11:28-30

CUE Jesus welcomes the weary; I may receive rest and practical help.**CONTEXT** Jesus' gentleness is an invitation, not a sleep or calm guarantee. Adults still respond to practical needs.**PROMPT** Choose water, a break, a safe adult, or a quiet drawing.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Rest, hope, and truthful voice **Near in grief**

REFERENCE Psalm 34:18

CUE God can be near when my heart is broken.**CONTEXT** Nearness does not erase grief; adults stay present and seek support when a child needs more care.**PROMPT** Place the card beside a comfort object or pass.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Rest, hope, and truthful voice **Hope without pretending**

REFERENCE Romans 5:3-5; Psalm 42

CUE I can hold hope while I wait, without pretending everything is fine.**CONTEXT** Christian hope grows through God's love and honest lament, not denial or a demand for a quick change.**PROMPT** Draw a road with a trusted helper on it.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Rest, hope, and truthful voice **Speak and listen truthfully**

REFERENCE Ephesians 4:25; James 1:19

CUE I can speak truthfully and listen carefully.**CONTEXT** Truthful speech includes privacy, consent, and a safe adult's help when a matter is too large for a child.**PROMPT** Use a turn-taking card or listen only.LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Growth and calling 

Grow over time

REFERENCE Philippians 1:6

CUE God is shaping my life over time; I am not finished.

CONTEXT Growth is God's ongoing work, not a demand for instant change or perfection.

PROMPT Draw one seed, step, or question.

LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Growth and calling 

Serve with love

REFERENCE 1 Peter 4:10

CUE I can use what I have to serve with love.

CONTEXT Gifts are for shared good, not rank. A child may contribute through words, art, movement, care, or rest.

PROMPT Choose a fictional way to help a group.

LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Growth and calling 

Learn and return

REFERENCE Proverbs 1:5; Luke 15:11-24

CUE I can learn, repent, and practise a new way with help.

CONTEXT Wisdom grows through listening and return; repentance never excuses abuse or removes a needed boundary.

PROMPT Complete next time I can ask with a general example, or pass.

LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

Growth and calling 

Called into loving community

REFERENCE 1 Peter 2:9; Micah 6:8

CUE In Christ I am called into a people who practise love, justice, mercy, and humility.

CONTEXT Identity leads toward faithful community and action, not superiority or a claim that life will be easy.

PROMPT Choose one ordinary act of welcome or fairness with adult support.

LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK ·
AAC · PASS

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
