STOP ANY TIME

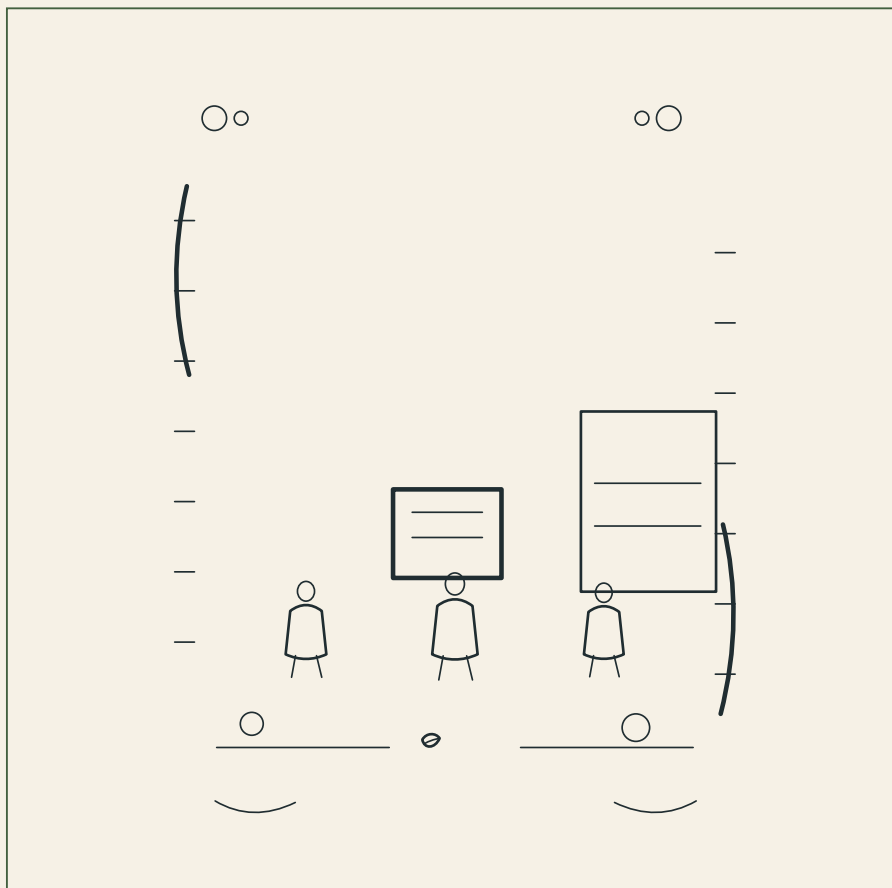
You do not have to keep going. We can stop, move, get water, or sit with a trusted adult.

Love looks for another person's good and
makes room for care.

CONTEXT

Galatians names love first in a connected list
of Spirit-shaped qualities, not as a badge a
child earns.

REFLECTION

Keep the scene observable and
fictional. A child may point, color, invent
a story, listen, or pass.

PROMPT

Where do you see room being made for
someone else? You may point, color,
invent a story, or pass.

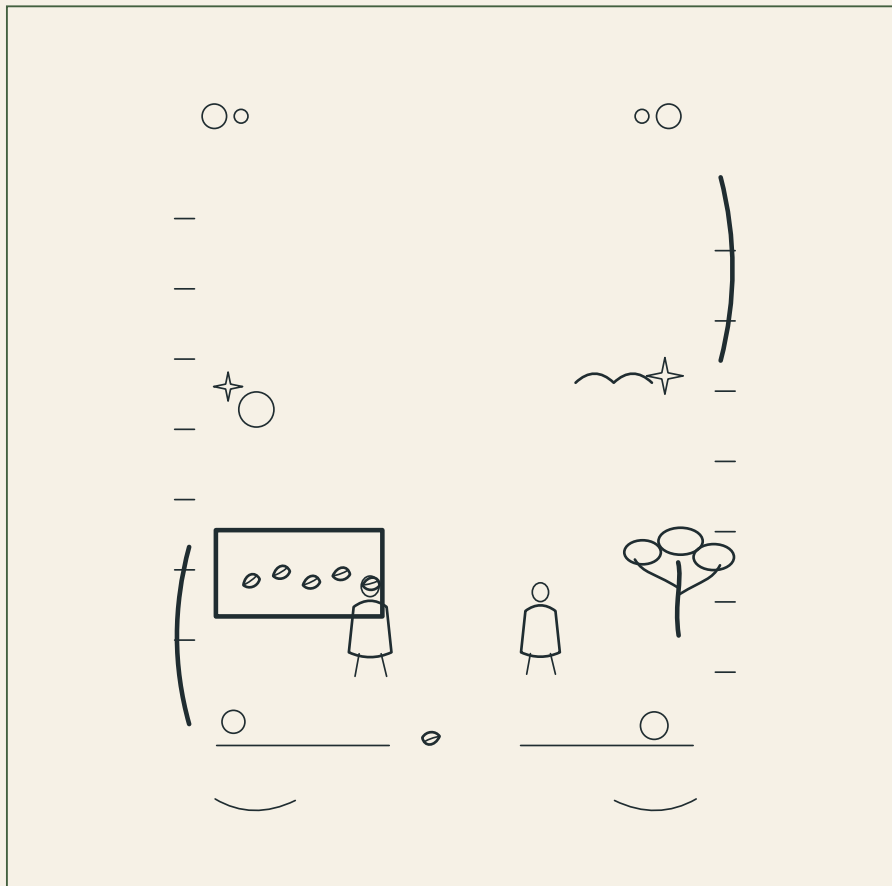
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

PARAPHRASE

Joy is gladness that can be noticed in an ordinary moment.

CONTEXT

The quality appears beside love and peace, showing a connected life rather than a demand for constant cheer.

REFLECTION

Notice one small detail without requiring a smile or a personal disclosure.

Listening and passing remain available.

PROMPT

What small detail could make this scene feel glad? You may choose colors, listen, or pass.

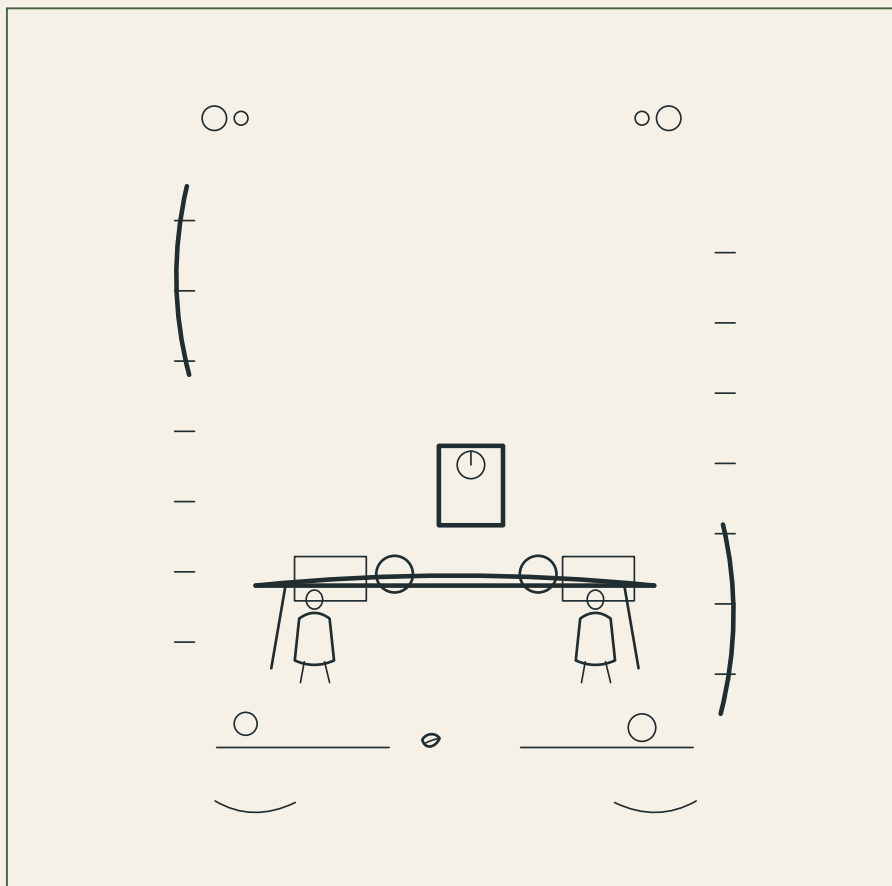
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Child and caregiver notice a small bird beside a simple garden.

Peace

PARAPHRASE

Peace can make space for listening,
boundaries, and a fair next step.

CONTEXT

Peace in this list is a way of relating, not a
guarantee that conflict or hard feelings
disappear.

REFLECTION

Point to an object that supports a
settled next step. Movement, AAC, and
a pass are welcome.

PROMPT

Which object helps the table feel
settled? You may point, move, draw,
use AAC, or pass.

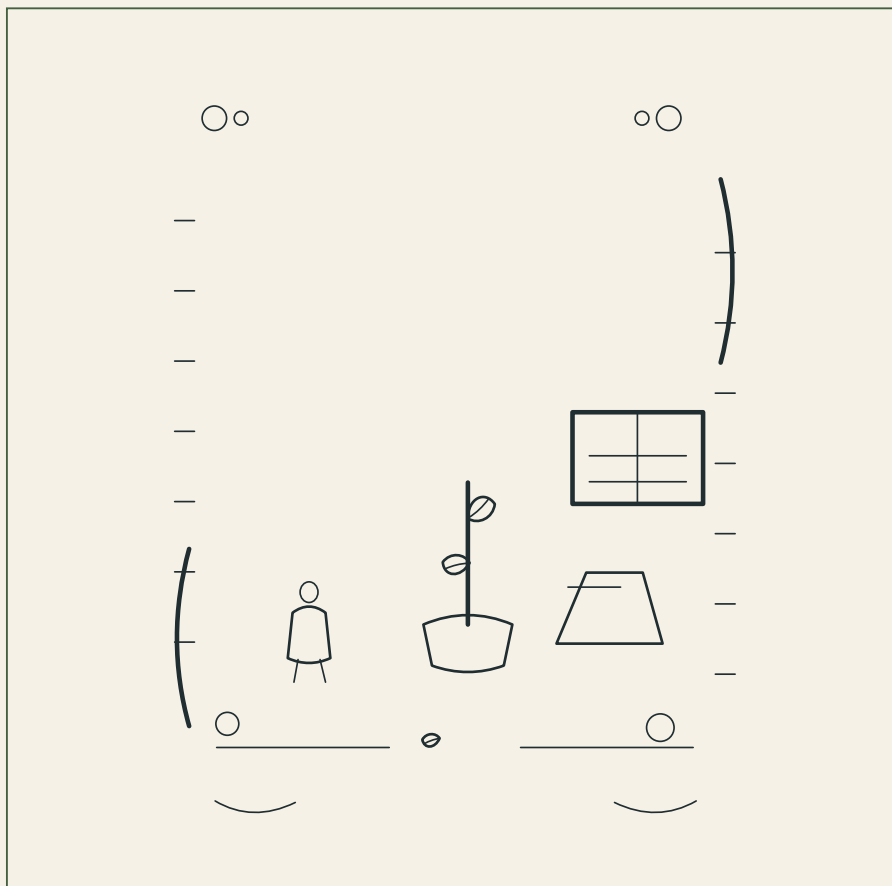
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Patience

PARAPHRASE

Patience gives people and living things time to develop instead of demanding instant results.

CONTEXT

The word belongs to a list of qualities shaped over time and practiced with other people.

REFLECTION

Use the plant as a fictional example. A child can choose a color, listen, draw, or pass.

PROMPT

What could someone do while waiting? Choose a color, draw a fictional idea, listen, or pass.

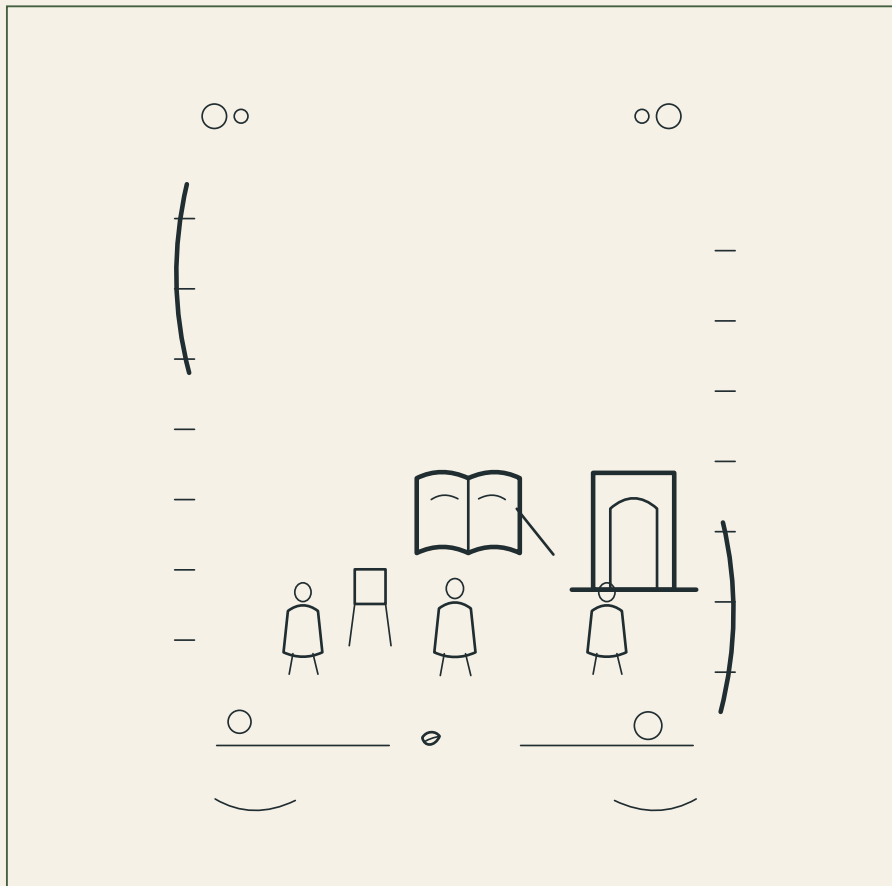
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Child waits beside a sprouting plant, watering can, and blank calendar.

Kindness

PARAPHRASE

Kindness notices a need and offers a
respectful, useful action.

CONTEXT

Galatians places kindness within a community
pattern. It does not label one person needy or
another person good.

REFLECTION

Keep the answer fictional and
consent-aware. Pointing, coloring,
listening, or passing all count as
participation.

PROMPT

What is one fictional helpful action in
this picture? You may point, color, or
pass.

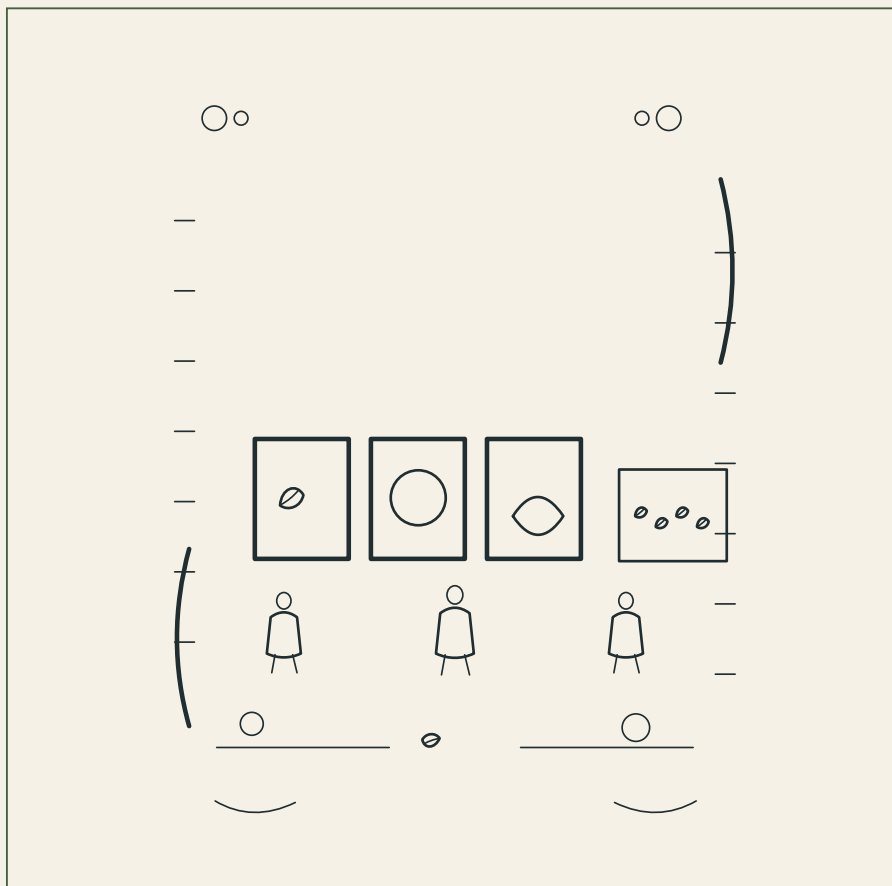
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Child offers a seat and book to a new
classmate while another holds a door.

Goodness

Galatians 5:22

PARAPHRASE

Goodness chooses what helps people and a shared place, even when no one is watching.

CONTEXT

This quality is part of the connected list, not a scoreboard for measuring a child or a group.

REFLECTION

Describe what is visible and leave room for another fictional choice. No child carries responsibility for every outcome.

PROMPT

Which choice helps the shared space? You may invent a fictional choice, listen, or pass.

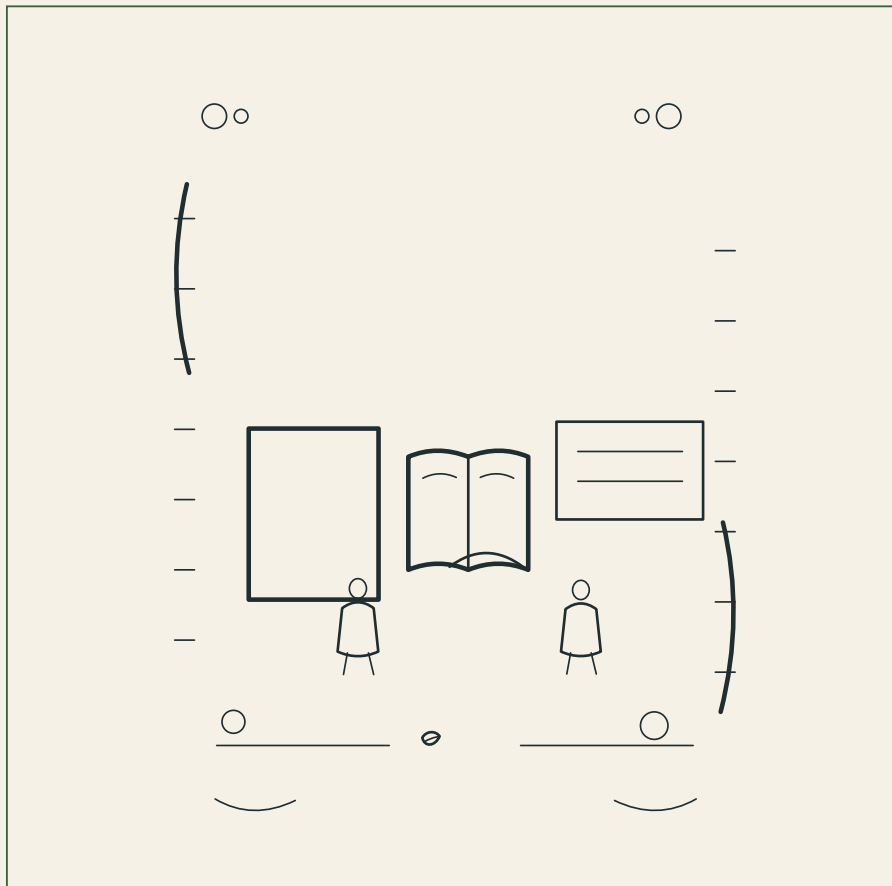
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Small group sorts plain reusable items beside a community garden.

Faithfulness

PARAPHRASE

Faithfulness keeps showing up, tells the truth about a mistake, and follows through when it can.

CONTEXT

The list describes a dependable way of living, while leaving room for limits, repair, and support.

REFLECTION

Use the blank card as a fictional prop. A child may dictate, color, listen, or pass without signing anything.

PROMPT

What could make a promise easier to keep? Choose a color, dictate a fictional answer, or pass.

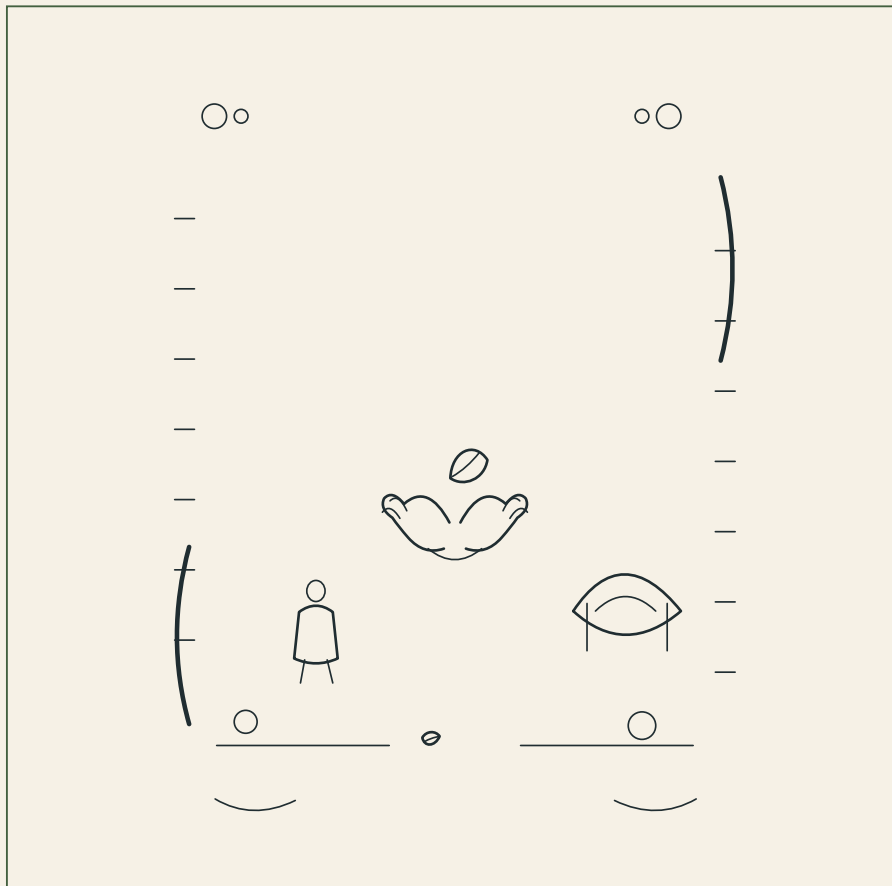
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Child returns a borrowed book to a librarian beside a blank promise card.

Gentleness

Galatians 5:23

PARAPHRASE

Gentleness uses care and strength without
pushing, grabbing, or humiliating.

CONTEXT

Gentleness does not mean tolerating harm. It
describes a careful way to use strength and
attention.

REFLECTION

Point to an open hand or another gentle
line. Use AAC, movement, listening, or
a pass as needed.

PROMPT

Which lines show a gentle choice? You
may trace them, listen, use AAC, or
pass.

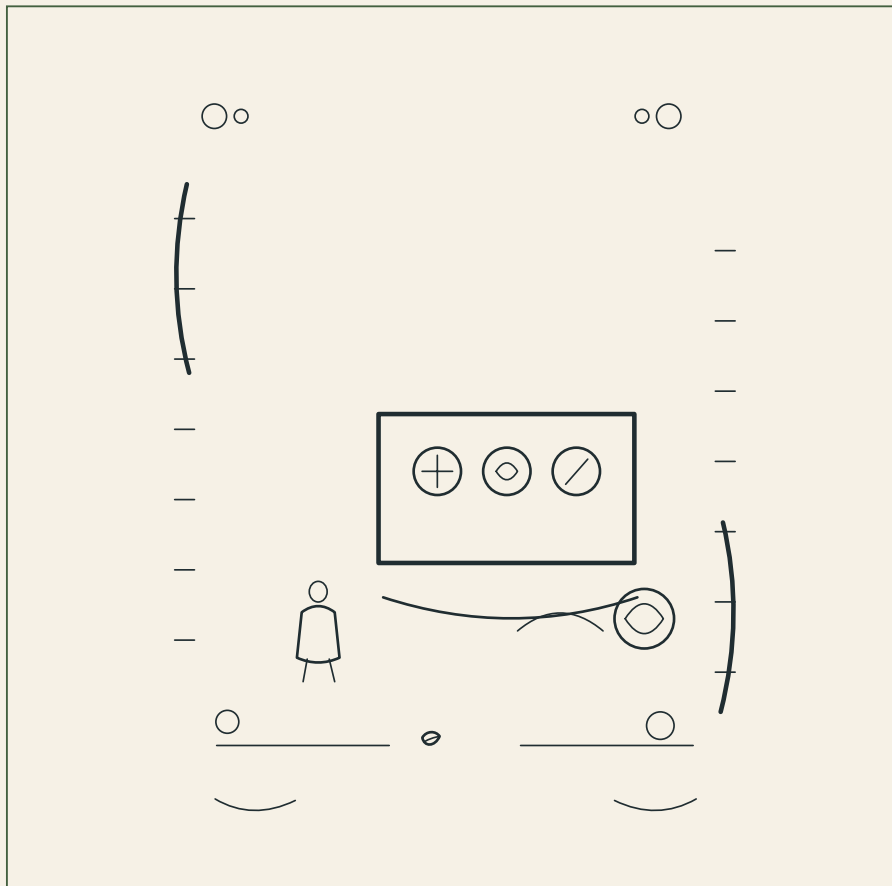
IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Child offers a leaf with an open hand near a

Self-control

REFERENCE

Galatians 5:23
PARAPHRASE

Self-control can create a pause so a person
can choose a kind next step and ask for help.
CONTEXT

The final quality is not forced silence or
willpower alone; people need real support,
access, and boundaries.

REFLECTION

Let the adult name the support
symbols. Never turn the picture into a
score or a diagnosis.

PROMPT

Which choice could help someone
pause? You may point, move, draw, or
pass.

IMAGE DESCRIPTION

Child pauses at a choice board with water,
movement, and help symbols before a game.
