Look and trace · CL

Use eight large line cards with an icon, a short paraphrase, and a point, trace, draw, or adult-write route.

METHOD SUMMARIES · eight Lord's Prayer lines

Our Father in heaven

Matthew 6:9; Luke 11:2

We speak to God as our Father in heaven.

Holy name

Matthew 6:9

May God's name be treated as holy and good.

God's reign

Matthew 6:10

May God's good reign be seen among us.

God's will

Matthew 6:10

May God's will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Daily needs

Matthew 6:11

Give us what we need for today.

Forgiveness and repair

Matthew 6:12

Forgive our wrongs as we learn to forgive.

Guidance and rescue

Matthew 6:13

Help us when we are tempted and rescue us from evil.

Prayer without performance

Matthew 6:5–15 context

We pray honestly, not to perform for an audience.

COMPARISON BOX · Matthew 6:11

Matthew 6:5–15 · teaching, shared prayer, and daily need.

Luke 11:1–4 · disciples ask Jesus to teach them to pray.

Adult answer and take-home page

EXAMPLE · the four responses are optional

REFERENCE

Matthew 6:11

Line: Give us what we need for today.

Context: Jesus' prayer uses us, so daily need is shared rather than a private shopping list.

Response: Today I can notice food, rest, help, or a safe grown-up. I can ask for what is needed and let an adult make a plan.

Draw, say, listen, or pass: draw a loaf, a helping hand, or an empty box; say one general need; listen while the adult prays; or pass.

TAKE-HOME CHECKLIST

Read the full passage in the family's Bible.

Offer draw, say, listen, AAC, movement, or pass.

Keep one adult nearby and do not collect private stories.

Leave a field blank when that is the wise response.

Adult answer route: read the context, model one wise response, and keep a no-speaking route open.

SAFETY NOTES

You do not have to keep going. Stop, move, get water, or sit with a trusted adult.

You can listen while I read, draw, move, keep your eyes open, use AAC, or pass.

For a persistent or unsafe concern, contact a trusted adult, the host safeguarding lead, a qualified professional, or local emergency services.

- Do not teach forgiveness as silence about abuse or as a reason to return to an unsafe person.
