

Christian Prayer Cube for Kids: Free Printable and Instructions

A six-page craft file with two variants, cut and fold guidance, a flat alternative, and safety notes.

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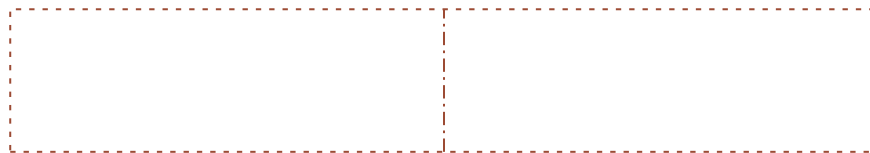
HOW TO USE

Adult-led · Ages approximately 4–12 · Participation is optional

LISTEN · DRAW · MOVE · SPEAK · AAC · PASS

STOP ANY TIME

You do not have to keep going. We can stop, keep our eyes open, move, draw, get water, or sit with a trusted grown-up.



CUT

FOLD

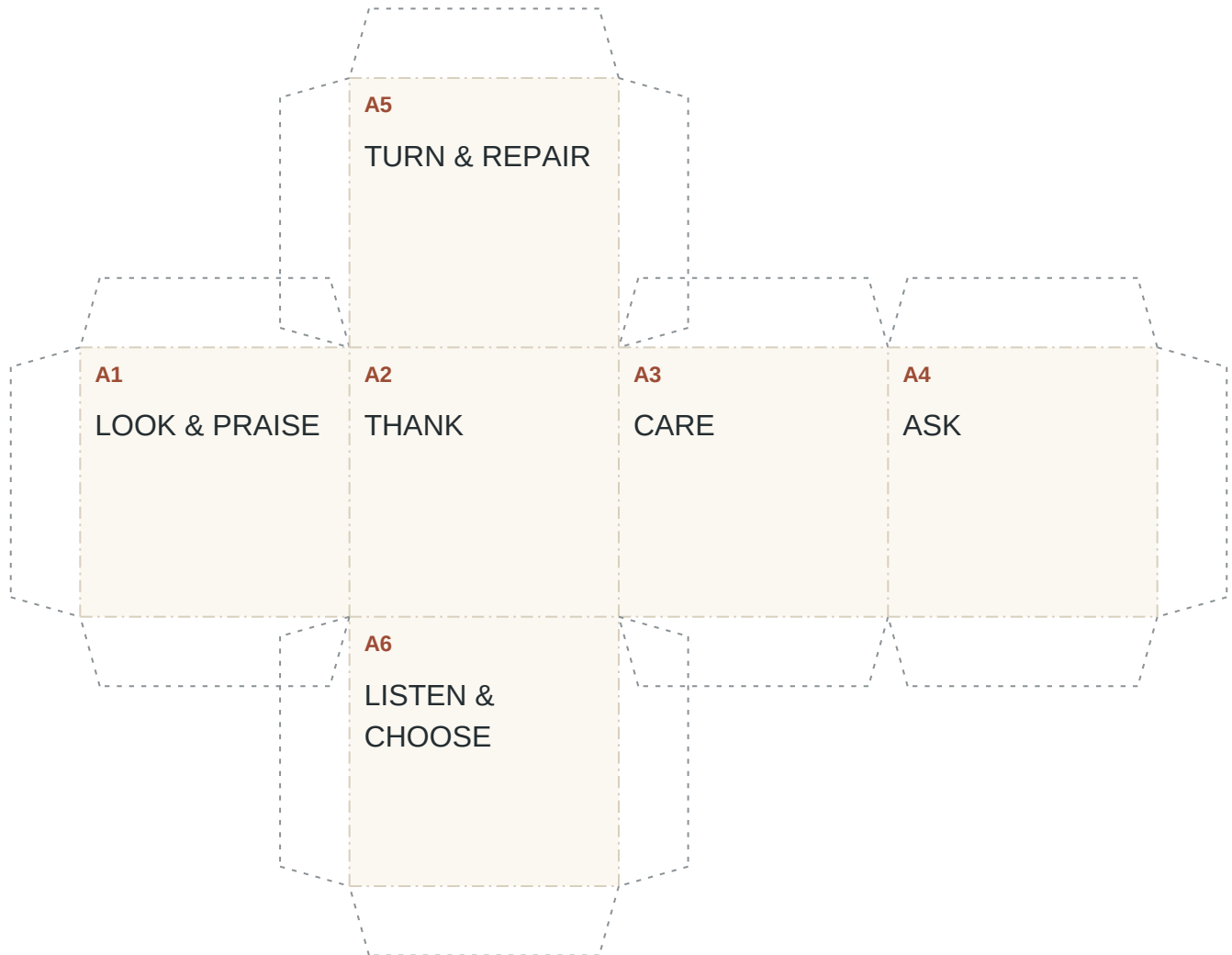

Variant A: Picture and phrase

Variant A · adult-only CUT and FOLD · print at 100% (Actual size)

CUT · dashed

FOLD · dash-dot



TABS ≥ 10 mm

CUT uses dashed lines. FOLD uses dash-dot lines. Keep all tabs attached.

Print at 100% / Actual size.

1-inch test square



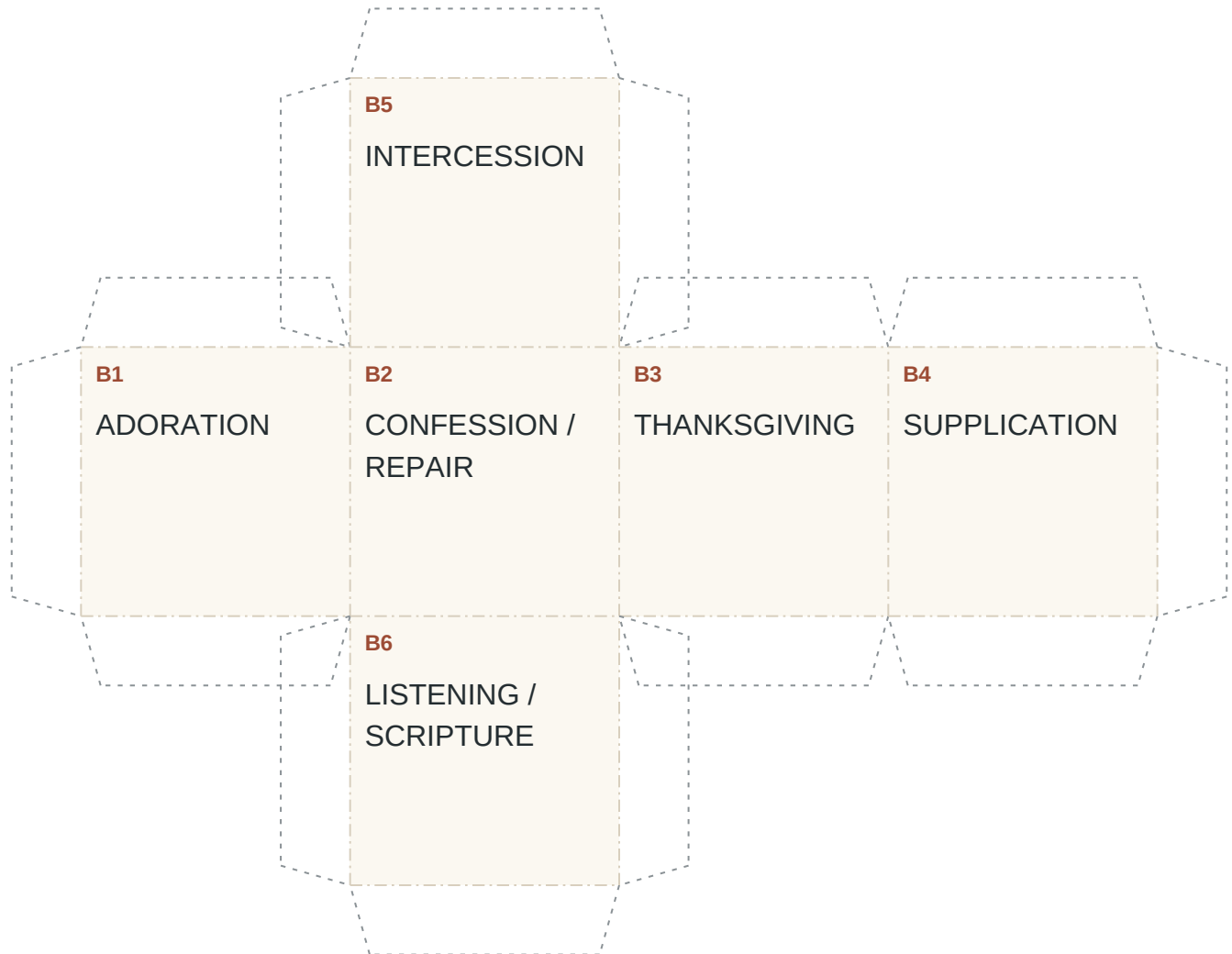

Variant B: Words and response

Variant B · adult-only CUT and FOLD · print at 100% (Actual size)

CUT · dashed

FOLD · dash-dot



TABS ≥ 10 mm

CUT uses dashed lines. FOLD uses dash-dot lines. Keep all tabs attached.

Print at 100% / Actual size.

1-inch test square



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Assembly steps and the one-inch test

Variant A: Picture and phrase: Six large face panels with picture cues and words · One adult-only cube net with CUT and FOLD marks · One-inch test square labelled Print at 100% / Actual size · Flat prompt card and repair strip

Variant B: Words and response: Six movement panels with words and response cues · One adult-only cube net with CUT and FOLD marks · One-inch test square labelled Print at 100% / Actual size · Flat prompt card and repair strip

1. CHOOSE AND PRINT

An adult chooses Variant A or B, prints on Letter or A4 at 100% / Actual size, and checks the one-inch test square before cutting.

Safety: Keep the flat net on a clear table. Children may colour while an adult prepares the craft.

2. CUT THE NET

CUT only on dashed lines marked CUT. Leave every tab attached, and keep the prompt key and repair strip on the page.

Safety: Cutting is adult-only. Use blunt-tip scissors; keep scraps away from mouths and do not use a craft knife.

3. FOLD THE MARKED LINES

FOLD on lines marked FOLD so each printed face stays outside. Make a soft crease and never force a fold through a word or icon.

Safety: An adult checks that the paper edge is smooth before handing over the finished cube.

4. JOIN THE TABS

Apply a glue stick or small tape pieces to the labelled tabs. Bring matching edges together in order: base, side, top, then final tab.

Safety: Use paper-safe glue only. No hot glue, staples, magnets, or loose decorations.

5. CHECK EACH SEAM

Hold each join while an adult checks the face order, corners, and printed words. Repair a loose tab with the strip on the prompt-key page.

Safety: Stop if the child is tired or frustrated. The flat card remains a complete alternative.

6. TEST AND STORE

Let the cube dry. An adult tests one gentle roll, checks the edges, and stores it in a labelled envelope or plastic container away from babies.

Safety: The cube stays adult-held for under-3 use. Do not leave small folded paper or scraps within reach.

7. CHOOSE A STARTING POINT

Before use, say: This roll only gives us an idea. You may choose another face, ask an adult to read it, draw, listen, or pass.

Safety: A prompt never requires a private disclosure, a spoken prayer, eye closure, or a particular response.

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Prompt key A

A1 · Look and praise

Notice one good thing in the room, outside, or in a Bible story.

You may say thank you, draw, point, listen while an adult prays, or pass.

Matthew 6:9-13

A2 · Thank

Name one ordinary gift or caring role.

A child may draw, point, listen, or pass without naming a person.

1 Thessalonians 5:18

A3 · Care

Pray for people, animals, or places that need care in broad terms.

Do not record private names or stories; a general prayer is enough.

1 Timothy 2:1

FLAT ALTERNATIVE · An adult handles printing, cutting, folding, gluing, testing, and storage. A flat prompt card is a complete no-cut alternative.

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Prompt key B

B1 · Adoration

Name something true about God's character shown in Scripture.

Faithful, merciful, wise, and near are examples; the adult supplies context.

Matthew 6:9-13

B2 · Confession and repair

Tell God the truth about a choice and ask for help to repair harm.

A child may keep the prayer private or skip this face.

1 John 1:9

B3 · Thanksgiving

Give thanks for a gift without pretending every circumstance is good.

Lament and thanks can both belong in prayer.

Philippians 4:6

B4 · Supplication

Ask for help, wisdom, daily needs, or courage.

Pair prayer with a practical next step and release the outcome.

Philippians 4:6

B5 · Intercession

Pray for another person or community in broad terms.

Do not record identifying details or make a child responsible for safety.

1 Timothy 2:1

B6 · Listening and Scripture

Read the surrounding passage, notice what it says, and choose a response.

A roll is a prompt choice, not a way to discern God's will.

Romans 12:12

REPAIR STRIP · Hold each join while an adult checks the face order, corners, and printed words. Repair a loose tab with the strip on the prompt-key page.

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
